






TIAN TAN BUDDHA

The beauty of the object is the result of 12 years of hard work, leading to a 34 metre-tall bronze statue weighing 250-tons. As the second largest outdoor Buddha in the world, its beauty is complemented by the surrounding ocean, trees, and mountains. While taking a tour of this monument, I learned that Buddha means "one who is awakened" and that this sculpture honours the founder of Buddhism, Siddhartha Gautama, a spiritual leader and philosopher.




KAUAI BLUE




PEGGY'S COVE SUNSETS




OAHU'S NORTH SHORE

- 1) Canvas prints include a high quality poly/cotton blend compared to poor quality synthetic polyester materials.
- 2) All of our prints are made in Canada and the U.S while others are often mass produced overseas with no quality assurance or control.
- 3) Our canvas is whitened using an eco-friendly process whereas some print companies coat their canvas with unstable chemical brightening agents.
- 4) We use a UV laminate that prevents fading for 200 years* while others use liquid laminate that cracks, fades, and turns yellow over time.

5) Our canvas is hand-stretched and mirror wrapped* while others may use extremely poor stretching that can lack tension and cause prints to sag.

6) We provide pre-installed hanging wires for Canada and U.S. orders instead of leaving you to buy your own accessories.

7) All images are direct from the photographer's digital files whereas others use photos from artists who may not have licensed the rights to sell their work.

8) We use an ultra-smooth matte surface on both photo and canvas prints, preventing glare from lights.


